The Martinborough Community Centre was Highly Commended for Engineering Innovation

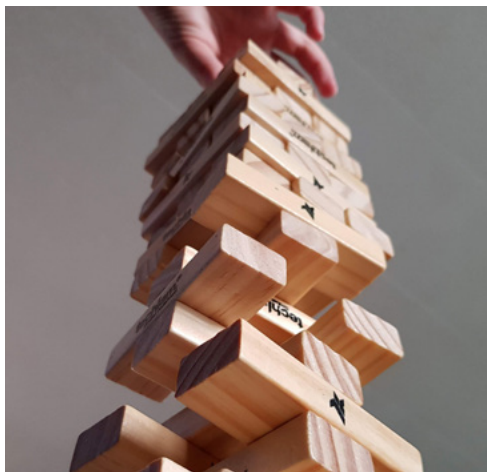
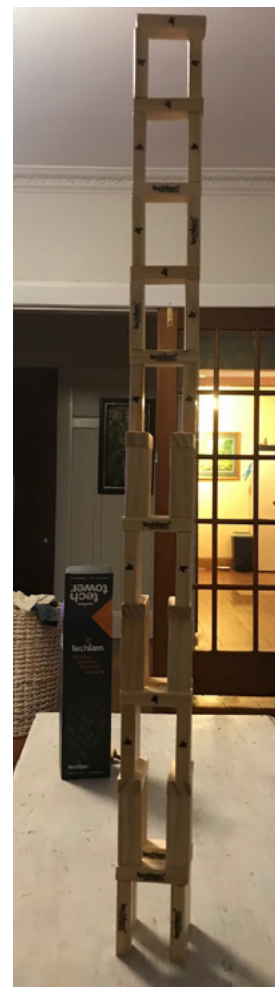
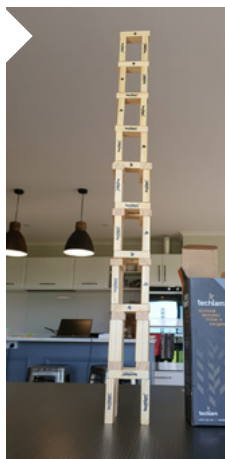
The Farmers Corner Toilet Pavilion was Highly Commended for Engineered Wood Products Innovation



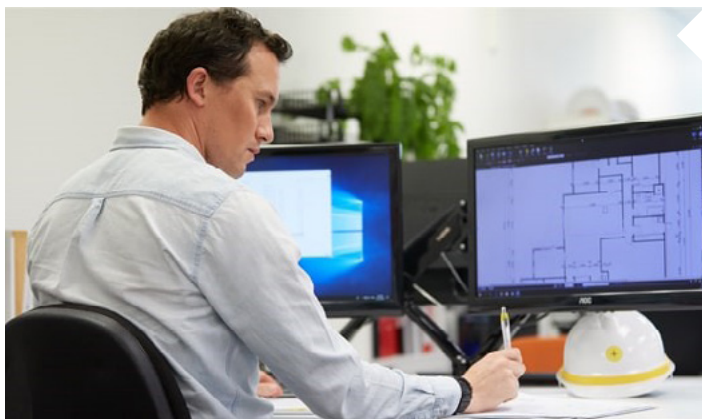
// Lockdown Techtower Challenge
